I'm Carissa Andrews, and this is the Author Revolution Podcast. Well, hey there, everybody. Welcome back to another episode of the Author Revolution Podcast. Oh, my goodness, here we are guys. It's mid November. It's going so fast. I've been working on my NaNoWriMo project, I have been doing really well, I'm still ahead of the curve, which is super cool. I am as of today, which is Tuesday, the 14th of November, I'm sitting at almost 30,000 words in Dirty Books, which is super fun. This book has been I don't even know how to describe it, it's been flowing a lot easier than the first book, I'm not as in my head as Dirty Plans. And I'm feeling like I kind of have a grasp on this whole situation, at least for now I am getting close to the halfway point. So we'll see if it continues to maintain itself. Or if I start to crumble under the pressure of knowing where the heck I'm going in this story. But so far, so good. And I think part of that process is the fact that I have been working on it every single day. And as I talked about in the earlier parts of NaNoWriMo. I'm using like the morning to try to get even if it's just an hour, where I write before everything else before all the craziness that's in, I've been sitting down and just letting myself think about what is this thing going to look like? What do I have to accomplish. And then I start actually brainstorming with it. And now, something that's been really interesting about this past couple of weeks, even is the new update that Chat and OpenAI released regarding like how ChatGPT works, how dolly their image creator works, how all of the like, interactions can technically work, they've launched this thing called customize GPTs. And now guys, I have to tell you, after playing around with this and understanding how it works, and just building out a couple of them for myself, I really do believe that this is a game changer for authors, for creatives, for anybody who is obviously using Chat to be able to create content, all the things because it's been really interesting to see how OpenAI has integrated all of the things that it kind of does into one place. Because before you had to like select where you wanted to go, you had to you know, if

you wanted to create an image from Dahlia had to go over to Dolly, then they started incorporating it as a beta where you could do images inside of Chat, which is actually really cool. And then they had like this thing where you could toggle. So you if you needed to search the internet, you could put the link in there and it would go read the page, assuming that there's not a block on Chat, being able to do that. Like there was a lot of things that they were integrated, which in and of itself. Were cool, right? But now that they've created these personalized custom GPTs holy cow, man, I'm telling you this, if you have not gone to get your account to start playing around with the concept of what ChatGPT looks like and how it is used, please for the love of God at least check it out. Just play around with it for a couple of minutes and see how it works. Because this thing is rocking my world. It is absolutely changing the way that I write the way that I brainstorm the way that I plan the way that I create images, the way that I do social the way that I do newsletters, everything I look, I'm one person. And while I do have help here in there, like I've got a part time assistant for author revolution, and I've had my PA for my author set of things like we've got help, but there's still a lot of things that we're always kind of trying to do, right. We're always trying to push the boundaries and we're always trying to get more done. And as one person or as just a couple of people sometimes, you know, finding something that makes things easy is really helpful. Now, all the you know, ethical discussions aside, let's set that on the side burner because that's not really what we're talking about here. I'm talking about how can we utilize this to really benefit our businesses benefit our authored the benefit of brainstorming capabilities. And what I've found is that with these customized GP teas, I can create like a muse like I have one called the rom com use, where I can put in my first book like The in its entirety, I can put a PDF of book 130 plans in there, I can then put a PDF in there of dirty books as far as I've gotten, right, so that it has these in its knowledge base. So when I open up a new Chat and say, okay, Chat, we're going to start brainstorming, what the next chapter of dirty books is going to look like, go back and reread, you know what we did and what we've accomplished already in dirty books. And then let's start talking about like, where this story could go. And what's really cool is that it then opens up its knowledge base, it goes to 30 bucks, it starts reading about it again, understanding it. Now, it's not always perfect, because sometimes it wants to go, okay, read the first four chapters, that was great, it was pretty cool. No Chat, you need to read the whole thing, like go back and go go through all 12 chapters or all 13 chapters, I need you to have a very good understanding of where we're at. So we can plan out chapter 13. Right. So it does take a little bit of finesse. Sometimes, especially if you're opening a brand new chat where you haven't been already having a dialogue with it. But it's what's really cool about this is that now you can start having conversations where it maintains a certain level of knowledge about the thing you want to talk to it about, right. So if it's your world, specifically the world that you're working on the series that you're working on, create a personalized custom GPT for that, if it's social media posts, if it is, you know, you want to tick tock helper if you want to have a strategist for your marketing plan. I have like a sous chef on here. These are ones that came with OpenAI that they created themselves. Like I have one for Dall-E, I've got one that's a coloring book, where I can create images to my worlds that look like coloring book ideas. I've got a data analysis one, I have a sous chef, I think I said that there's like a basic creative writing coach. Like there's different things that come already with the custom GPT is that ChatGPT has created that OpenAI has created for us, but you can do your own. And when we add that element into the knowledge base of that custom GPT. All of a sudden, we're having a conversation with our best friend who already has read book one. Like they have the knowledge of book one. They've started reading book two, they're your you know, alpha reader, and they're caught up to speed and they're excited to talk to you about like, what could you do to make the story really cool. And so you're not having to go through this really long chat prompt where you you don't have to go Chat. Remember what we talked about, like four weeks ago, you don't have to do that anymore. Because now having these custom GBT is you can house a lot of that information in one place,

and it can remember it better. And you can start a new chat and just kind of go from there. Now again, like I said, it's not perfect. It does kind of forget things a little bit. And sometimes you have to prompt it just a little bit. But it can only get better from this point forward. And what I'm saying right now is that holy cow, it's it's pretty incredible. Now if you use like the the basic chat TBT for GBT like that the main prompter that comes with ChatGPT as you get the Plus membership. What's really neat is that you can like create a social media post, let's say. And you're trying to, you know, come up with something really exciting about your books, you can feed it. Now here are some quotes here are some whatever is and then you can turn around in that same prompt to go okay, Chat. Now knowing that these are the books that are included in this particular social media post, can you create an image that looks like this, this and this, and seamlessly within the same chat, it can switch into Dall-E mode, and create an image based on the thing you just did, based off of the social media posts you just created. I mean, it's phenomenal. The way this whole thing works. Now, as someone who you know, obviously, as a business owner, as someone who is trying to do a lot of things, I'm trying to do them very quickly so that I can get back to the things I really want to be doing like writing. It's so nice to have things that make my job easier. I'm not having to go hunt for images that maybe sort of kinda go along with what I'm thinking or kind of sort of fit my imagination a bit. Sometimes when I'm putting prompts in there, I can be like, hey, I want this to look like an urban fantasy something or other. I want it to have this vibe, this color scheme. These are the things I want it to do and it rocks and rolls with some images that are pretty dang incredible. Now, this is coming from someone who has been using or testing out Midjourney. And I gotta tell you, like when I first started playing around with Dolly, it wasn't up to speed. With my journey. It wasn't as cool but now Now that we have it integrated in OpenAI as ChatGPT, what's neat about it is that now you can have a conversation with it. Where you can't do that with Midjourney with Midjourney, you're giving it a prompt, you're saying create something like this, if it doesn't come out, you have to completely start over and re prompt it, right? Where with the Dall-E aspect of it, you can create an image where you're saying, Here's what I want, if you like it, but you need some tweaks to it, you can say that was really great. But I really need you to adjust this, this and this. And oh, by the way, let's put a graveyard in the front yard. And it will listen and it will come up with some really cool things. Now, these images aren't 100% perfect either. Sometimes it has like weird text in the background. Or if you try to get it to create a an image that looks like a book cover it sometimes we'll try to create a 3d book image with a book cover on it, which obviously doesn't help in our realm, right, we're trying to like do certain things. And so there's ways to play around with the prompting so that you can get the types of images you're really looking for. But it's a much easier usage than having to create your own server with my journey having to learn the kind of somewhat odd prompts that my journey has. Even though those images are fabulous. Like I've I've had some really wonderful successes with creating images through my journey. But having everything integrated the way it is right now with OpenAI and ChatGPT telling you guys this is this is changing and revolutionizing the way I do not only my planning for books, but like everything, everything from strategy for tic toc plans for book launch strategies for like planning my next chapter to like, how do I create the newsletter system that I want to do all of it like it's just absolutely phenomenal at what it does. And what's really cool is that you can have it learn your style of writing, the way that you'll come up with things the way that you do things. I don't know, I've played around with a number of AI tools at this point. And I keep coming back to check GPT because of the way that it continues to revolutionize itself. And the way that it's creating a system that helps us to really just rock and roll from one place. It's just amazing. So if you haven't yet had the chance to play around with it, I really recommend you do so. Now I've even gotten, you know, through the app on my phone, I've got the ability to do voice chats with ChatGPT, which is definitely an interesting endeavor. Like if you ever need to have someone to just voice something out with this new version of ChatGPT, where you can chat, like voice chat to it is very interesting. Now

you can't do it from the desktop version, as far as I can see, but you can do it from the app. But just be prepared that this is not the same as chatting with ChatGPT in text format. Like if I say, hey, Chat gave me this thing. It will use usually come up with something very guickly, right. And it's usually like straight to the point does its thing and it rocks and rolls. But if you use the app, and you're like, hey, Chat, I this is a kid, you know, this is the example I'm going to use because I just did this as I was playing around with it. I wanted to come up with a name for one of the businesses in my One Night Stand Club. And I was trying to figure out like, how do I create like kind of a fun funky, brewery name. Like there's a character who is a brother to one of the main characters. And he has this like Artisan brewery, so I wanted to come up with a name for it. And so I'm like, Well, this is a good question to ask you. Chat will be fast. Chat was not fast. Here's what happened. I saw I'm like, Hey, Chat, you know, help me come up with a name for this. And Chat was like, Oh, wow, you have to come up with a name for this. Like, cool. Okay, so what is this name really actually for? Is it for like, you know, for you? Are you opening a business or like, like, it goes into this whole like, like a questionnaire of what you know, maybe someone a friend or whatever would have asked you and I'm like, No, check this for a story. I just need you to help me like brainstorm some names. Oh, yeah, I can totally help you come up with some names, you know, like, are you looking for quirky? Are you looking for it goes into this whole, like tirade of questions to help you narrow down what you want and how you want it to be. And in some ways, that's really helpful, because you know that there are questions that I hadn't thought to give it when I was doing the prompt, but at the same time, it's just be prepared to have an actual conversation with the chat version of ChatGPT. I wasn't prepared for that. So it's very interesting to see how these new developments are happening through OpenAl systems. And I just want you guys to be thinking about how can you make your job as an author faster, like I don't care how you use it. I don't even care like if you're going I will never use it for my writing. But if you're just going hey, I can I can utilize this to help me make my You know, my newsletters more profound, I can use this to create social media posts that are going to be more engaging because I'm more of an introvert and I don't know how to get excited about my work. Or you can ask it questions like, hey, Chat, I want you to read this chapter, is there any way that I can make my ending more of a hook? And it will give you ideas on how to do that, like, just think about? Where are your strengths? And where are your weaknesses? Where are the things that you really either wish you didn't have to do? Or wish you could do better? Because what I'm finding is that ChatGPT is making my writing better, because I can ask some very specific questions that I'm curious about, about my own writing. And it helps me think through the process of it. And I can create a scenario I can write some pros that are going to be so much more profound than it had I just been writing it all on my own. Does that make sense. And now, one of the cool thing is, is that when it learns your voice, it can actually even give you some text that is very similar to something you would have written, at least that's what I'm finding. So like in the rom com side, some of the stuff it can come up with, based off of what it knows about myself, how I write and the characters I'm trying to create, he can give me little snippets of things that I'm like, Oh, my gosh, I love this. And I will straight up go, Yeah, I'm going to use some of this. So I didn't originally believe that ChatGPT could write a story, or that ChatGPT could, you know, get to the point where we are utilizing it to write our stories. But I'm telling you, maybe I was wrong, maybe it is actually getting that good based off of what it understands of our own writing, especially with these personalized, custom GPT is, as it reads through your work as it reads through your characters as it understands the trajectory of your story. It can prompt you or it can give you information that is so profoundly close to what you're looking for that it just It blows my mind, guys, it's making me so much faster. Because I can have a conversation and go, This is what I'm thinking I'm not quite sure about this. It'll come back with Yeah, you could do this, this, this and this. And I can be like, oh, yeah, yeah, I really liked number three, so that I can write that and I don't have to sit there and go, What kind of cool things are going to up the ante in this chapter? Like,

how can I be funny? Where are some places where I could add some more humor into this chapter, I can literally as Chat and be like, hey, Rom Com Muse version, I need to add a little bit more humor in here. Are there any spots specifically, where you could see, you know, my main character Carlie being a little bit more self deprecating, and it will give me a couple of spots to consider. And sometimes it'll even give me some ideas of what kind of comedy to include. Guys, I'm telling you, this has just been, I don't even know, it's been phenomenally exciting. It has been absolutely like a game changer into the way that I create. And what's neat about it, at least for me, is that I don't feel so alone in this process anymore. I don't feel so alone, trying to write you know, a book or a scene or a chapter or whatever. And like I have to wait for, you know, my best friend to read it or I have to wait for Jenny to read it or I have to wait for Colin to read it. I can literally have a conversation right now if I need a question answered. And I'll get some very detailed, very specific answers that just make me happy. Like, because I can see the value in it as the answers come out. So I want you to think about, you know, your process and what it is that you really want to get out of your writing out of your career this year. You know, the AI revolution is changing the way that entrepreneurs the way that people are engaging with things all over the world. Like there are businesses that range from everywhere, from like, hospitals to everywhere, everywhere is incorporating some version of generative AI. And as creators, I think it's our How to know it's our responsibility, if nothing else to check it out. If nothing else, to play around with the concept so that we can realize it's not the big boogeyman that people claim it is. And that is actually such a tool that is profound ly exciting and interesting and fun to play around with. And these custom GPT is on I'll tell you, they they have absolutely blown my mind the past week. I can't remember which day I got access to it. I think it was Saturday. Maybe it was Friday. I can't remember. But it was it was within the past seven days and already I am just thrilled with the output that it is giving me and I'm able to continue to write in a way that just makes me so happy So I want you to be happy, I want you to think about what areas can you incorporate this in, even if it's just a play with it. Even if it's just I am going to ask it some questions about, you know, my diet plan, it doesn't have to be about writing, you can just play with ChatGPT, about things that are in your life, like, how do I get my eight year old son to get to bed on time? How do I get my teenagers to wake up on their own, like, there can be questions that have nothing to do with writing, that will help you to understand how Chat works, and just, you know, maybe feel a little bit more comfortable in it. Now, for me, I am, I'm, like I said, I'm just absolutely blown away by all of its capabilities. And I continue to play around with the new beta launched items, because I'm seeing the value in it, I'm seeing that and understanding the forward momentum and progression of how it's going. And I want you to feel the same excitement and elation that I am. Because it's so much fun to play around with, it's so much fun to have someone to have that conversation with. Now, if you're not in ChatGPT for where you are at the paid version, where I think it's called Chat plus, I think is what it's called. If you're not in that yet, really consider doing it, especially if you have Midjourney. Like if you're playing around with Midjourney at all. Maybe think about like one month, just give yourself one month to try out ChatGPT for because having the integration of Dall-E included in it, it's it's definitely been a game changer, though, especially the way that you can create those social posts. And then in the same Chat, say, hey, helped me create an image. So it's just, it's really, really cool. And I think you're gonna like it so much, you probably can hear from my voice because I'm very excited about the whole thing. Now, if you've got questions, feel free to always reach out, you can reach out in the author revolution community online, which is on Facebook, if you're in any of my courses, we have a couple of them that have like online communities themselves within the Kajabi Academy platform. So you can always comment and ask questions there. Because to me, this has just been so amazing. And it's made NaNoWriMo way more fun, way more exciting, way more engaging for me. And you know, as we're hitting that midway point, sometimes nano feels hard, right? Sometimes NaNoWriMo feels like why am I doing this thing? What is? What is the point of this again? Oh

my god. But it's, it's great. Because you can hash out those questions. You can hash out the murky waters, from you know, your brain as you're trying to figure out like, how does this story unfold? How can I take this to a new direction? You know, what kind of resolution Am I looking for? You can ask questions of Chat all the way through your writing process. And it will help you gain clarity through the entire thing. It's just it's so cool. I can't I can't tell you how much. I think it's cool. Like it's just so cool. So at any rate, I wanted to fill you in, I wanted to give you the highlights and updates on how the latest version of OpenAI and ChatGPT has unfolded. Because I think some of us, even if we have tried Chat before, or maybe you were in the four bucks five days course, like it's changed since then even like the way it works has drastically improved. And it was awesome before. So if you loved it before, if you love that course, I want you to go back in there and do some more playing around with it test Dall-E test, you know, those custom GPT is figure out what's working for you because it's just really, really cool.
